



Athletic Commitment

1. Academic Eligibility Requirements
 - The student/athlete must maintain at least a 2.00 G.P.A.
2. Personal Conduct Commitment
 - Student/athletes will adhere to all National University Academy (NUA) rules
 - NUA student/athletes are expected to represent the school in a manner consistent with the expectations of NUA and the California Interscholastic Federation's (CIF) six (6) Pillars of Character and their Principles of Pursuing Victory with Honor
3. Attendance Commitment
 - The athlete is expected to be punctual and attend all practices, games and team activities
 - Only absences for medical purposes or unexpected serious personal incidents (as determined by the school administration) will be considered excused absences
 - Consequences from any absence, excused or not can include loss of playing time or a starting position at the discretion of the Head Coach
 - Unexcused absences may result in suspension or removal from the team
4. Academic Commitment
 - The student/athlete is expected to stay current with all assignments and coursework.
 - The student/athlete is expected to stay on track to complete all of their subject material within the semester timeframes that they are given.
5. Athletic Commitment
 - Try outs may be conducted for any team, based on the number of interested athletes.
 - When a player is selected to be a part of a team, they will have one week to give involvement a try. After one week, they are committed for the season. Commitment to a team requires attendance at all practices, games and award activities. The only exceptions are due to illness, family emergencies medical appointments.
 - A student that participates on an “outside team”, one not governed by CIF, may be subject to limited or delayed eligibility on the high school team. Please consult your coach or the athletic director for more details.
6. Team Commitment
 - Athletic teams do not operate as a democracy, nor are individual-oriented. The head coach administers each program at their discretion and their decisions are predominantly team oriented and require adherence.
